

2010 Quilt Challenge – “Who Am I?”

For this year's challenge you have been asked to make a quilted wall-hanging no smaller than 16" x 16" and no larger than 36" x 36". You can use any fabrics and colors you want. You may use embroidery, buttons and other embellishments as needed to complete your entry. The quilt should depict something about you. It could be your heritage, a hobby, a favorite thing, etc.

Below you will find some examples/suggestions to help you get started. Perhaps you have a favorite hobby like sewing/quilting, or one involving sports or nature like hiking or camping. Maybe it's about your heritage like your birthplace, or you like to travel. The possibilities are endless so explore your creativity and have fun with it.

- Size:** No smaller than 16 x 16 and no larger than 36 x 36.

- Name Your Quilt:** There will be a sign-up sheet when you bring in your quilt to put your name and the quilt name. Please also have your name on the back of your quilt. During the Viewers choice judging we will be on our honor not to look on the back so we will not be influenced in the judging.
